#### California State PTA's Mission and Objectives

Our mission is to positively impact the lives of all children and families.



#### Torrance Council and California State PTA

Leadership team supports, trains and mentors all 30 Torrance PTAs.

Provide training, family engagement and resources including Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Toolkit.



### **Our Goals For this Taskforce**

#### Strategic Goals for the Taskforce

Connect with families with students in special education and understand their needs and challenges when interacting with or participating in PTA sponsored activities Gain deeper understanding of barriers for participation Explore how our PTAs can better partner with and support families Understand how Torrance Council might provide resources: Community events, Parent/Guardian education, PTA mentorship and guidance

#### Important to Note

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Focus of taskforce work is on PTAs within Torrance, NOT Torrance Unified policies or Education Code

Budgeting and programming decisions are specific to each board Understand that limitations might often be understanding, volunteer base and financial constraints

## **PTA Funding Explained**

#### 1

#### Funding with a Purpose

Fundraising with a purpose (3:1 rule of thumb)

Funding/Programs focused on the widest amount of students

Budget development and review process with approval from Board and Association

#### **2** Balance with Equity

Historically little understanding or knowledge that students or families left out of PTA programming discussions

Realization that inclusion require changes to programming, process and funding



### **Goal: Supporting Our Units**

#### Understanding Needs

Provide feedback, guidance and support to local PTA leaders on how to start these discussions, develop partnerships, drive inclusion and accessibility in all that we do.

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#### **Resources and Training**

Highlight available resources and specialized training for units.

Produce or provide new resources to support unmet needs.



#### **Encouraging Involvement**

Promote active involvement and feedback from SPED families.

Work closely with their school sites and administrators to revamp PTA programming.

#### Training & Support

Bring our entire community together in meaningful ways that support inclusion, understanding and collaboration.

#### **Volunteer Opportunities**

Taskforce and PTA participation
